



Use of Recreational Property Community Organizations

Pace Water System (PWS) welcomes your organization/group to use the recreational property pavilion and/or meeting room by completing the Use Agreement, paying the Organization User Fee of \$200 per day, paying the refundable Security Deposit of \$200, and following the Property Rules. Please note that gambling and events with a political agenda are prohibited on the property. All events must commence and conclude during the timeframe documented and approved in the Use Agreement.

Parking and Logistics:

1. Groups of 50 or more attendees must provide transportation to accommodate limited parking within the property.
2. Parking is available in designated areas of the recreational property (see map). The organization/group is responsible for directing vehicles to the designated parking areas for the event and, if numbers/conditions warrant, providing auxiliary transportation from vehicles to the pavilion/meeting room.
3. Gate:
 - a. All organizations/groups must have a monitor at the gate to allow entrance and exit for attendees.
 - b. The gate must be closed and locked at the conclusion of the event.

Property Rules:

1. The group leader must sign in and out at the PWS office for receipt and return of access card/key.
2. Children under the age of 18 must be supervised at all times by responsible adults.
3. All posted signs must be obeyed.
4. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
5. Domesticated animals are allowed if under the control of their owner at all times.
6. All-terrain vehicles (ATVs/UTVs) are prohibited.
7. Vehicles must remain on established roadways or in designated parking areas.
8. Fishing, boating, and swimming are prohibited.
9. Hunting and firearms activities are prohibited.
10. Campfires are only allowed in designated pits.
11. Fireworks are prohibited.
12. Cutting trees is prohibited.

13. Camping is prohibited.

14. All trash must be picked up, bagged, and removed from the property when leaving.

Any of the above rules not adhered to will result in being asked to vacate the property immediately and may result in future access being denied. The PWS Board of Directors reserves the right to modify any of the above rules as deemed necessary to protect health, safety, and/or welfare.
